(Yes) When I was at school, my uncle told me that, he have a daughter at Accra, so I should go and stay with her (Oh something - Please, start again.

Something was wrong) (It's all right, its alright) (Let me see, let me see.

Let me look it properly) (Hold it upwards and

see) (It is like this) (Yes it good) (It is

low) (I know it is low) (Look, whether it

is working) (Yes) See, whether the first

one has come) (Yes) (See, whether the first

talking will come) (Yes)

(Maybe it has come) (please, lets try

again, you said you were at Ash Town)

Yes, I was born at Ash. Town. I attended

Roman Girls (Yes) And my uncle ~~sent~~^{took} me

to her daughter at Accra (Yes) that I

should stay with her. And he didn't

send me to school, till I return back,

and I was sent to New Tafu,

Desh Dechemso (Yes) And at there, I attended school till form two, but I couldn't finished and I brought forth (Yes) So, at the time I brought forth, it turned turned to marriage and trading (Yes) So, at first, I was selling tomatoes at Bode. (Yes) When I left there, I again came to this shed and sold onions. (Yes) But the man, whom I was living with him we divorced. (Yes) Now, it is only trading I do. (Yes) That I am doing (Yes, and at the time you left school, what was the very type of work did you like to do?) If I come from school - (no) (She said, when you stopped school) Yes (What type of work did you like to do?) When I stopped, what I liked to do was trading. That was what I did. (And what happened that you decided to sell that tomatoes?) (Why did you like to sell tomatoes?)

Oh. Somebody who didn't finished school, there is no work you can do, so, it is the only thing you ^{have to} do or (Yes) sell. There is no work for you to do that you can do (Yes) (Yes) (And why didn't you go and sold the onion early?) (Ho-ho-ho) (You then taught you would get more profit from tomatoes than onions) No. That was what my mother ~~sells~~ sold then (Aah) And I sold some. (True) Yes.

Before I started selling the onions, that was what my mother sold. (Yes) (But why? you know that, some people who ,)

didn't finished school, they like to learn something - maybe she would learn how to sew, or maybe she would learn how to dress hair) Yes (Why didn't you liked such things?) About that, please (Or you like ~~to~~ to get quick money?) Yes, but I was not interested in those things (aaah) (Yes) (You are interested in tomatoes?) Yes) (And as you were interested in tomatoes why, then, ~~did~~ you ~~stop~~ selling it?) I said my mother was selling it, and I went to sell some for her, later I got my own table and I said, I started selling Onions. (Yes) Yes that one, I was selling it with my mother Yes, (And you want to sell onions by yourself?) Yes, (And ~~as~~, you said that, onions maybe, why did you stopped selling tomatoes and sell that onion?) (That is why she left, the tomatoes she was selling) (Yes) when she left school (Yes) She went and do the same work with her money. (Yes) Now she is grown up. (Yes) (So she have to move from her mother, (Yes) and work for herself. (Yes) So, she doesn't like her mother's work again. She likes onions. (Can you sell tomatoes, including your mother's work?) (Ah) (She said) (Why did you left your mother, and sold the tomatoes at a different place?) Yes, I can ~~also~~ sell at the place which was mine, (Yes) If you sell tomatoes at that place, they would not buy it, & that place is only full of ^{the} ~~the~~ onions. That was the reason why, I also sold

Some of the onions. (Oh yes, I understand.) Did some of your relatives sell onions? Yes, my elder sister, and the one after her, both of them sell onions. (Yes) And I, also sell ~~came~~ and sell some. (So do you go to your sisters?) Yes (Do your mother continue selling?) Yes, She ^{is} still ~~continues~~, (Is it the tomatoes?) Yes, she is still selling ~~tomatoes~~ tomatoes (Yes) (So, one of your sisters is with your mother?) Yes. It is her granddaughter who is with her. (Yes, her granddaughter sell onions) Yes, (Yes) (So, all your sisters sell ~~tomatoes~~ ^{onions}) Yes, they sell ~~tomatoes~~ ^{onions}, some of them also have travelled. (Yes) Hmm (Tomatoes and onions, which of them is profitable?) It is all the same (Yes) Both of them, it is not everyday, that you would get profit. (Yes) All of them are fruits. So, at time, it is plenty (Yes) At times, there is none. (Yes) (So now, how is the trading in the onions, does it moves, if is it good, is it good?) It is good. (Is it profitable?) Yes (Yes) (So now if somebody sells onions, can she save the money to do property?) Eh If, you try and save it, you can save it to do property, because, my mothers whom I ~~met~~ followed them in the sheds, everybody have saved it (empty) This work. You can save it to do, (Do you know somebody who have a make property?) Yes, I have seen two people persons (Yes) (What did they do)

to get property?) You said? - - - -
 (Oh it is nothing. And if they received
 If they made properties, what do they
 do to get profit than the others?)

(Those who are able to make
 properties, what ^{they do} to get profit to
 do properties, while ^{some} of them
 Couldnt ~~do~~ get some?) If those people
~~elders~~, elders who have sold it for a
 longer period period. So, they received
 it more, and we go and ^{collect} get some from
 them. Every time, they get more
 profit. And we collect some from them.
 We collect from them, so she can
 save it in government bank, she save
 it at all the banks. So she can save
 it (So, they received more profit) Yes
 It is like, you see that, if we leave
 it, and it becomes more, you get profit)
 Yes, the profit come in bulk bulk.

(And if it is little) Yes, you see. Like
 we, we buy it little by little, but they
 buy it more. And we buy it ^{some} from
 them. And they again add some money
 O. How they bought it, the add more to
 it again. And you would go and buy
 from them. So after you have finished
 Your profit will reduce - (Yes)

(Those people whom you started ~~to~~
 selling the onions with them at the
 same time, have some of them got
 money than the others?) Yes, peoples
 who started at the same time, some of)

them have got money than the others.

(Yes, and some have got money than the others, what did she do that she became prosperous in her trading?) O.K.

If somebody is there, and she have no money, something like that, this and that
 when more are there If you go for one onion, ~~A kata~~ hundred thousand, if you didn't pay for it, they would not allow you to bring it (Yes)

Some of them don't have money to pay (Yes) So, if somebody goes and buys it, she also goes and buys some from her. So, that person's money, it is not plenty. The one who have money, would get money (Yes)

Hmm. (And what do they do to get money, that they have money?) You said, ^{why} what

did they do to get money? (Hmm, you

Said, Some have money to buy more, Some have no money) Then it is from her home. Maybe ^{it comes from} her husband (Oh, so?)

gave it to her, maybe ~~her~~ father gave it to her, maybe ~~her~~ mother gave it to her

You cannot know. (Yes) So, She have her money. She ^{old} handle it. And she uses it

for her business (Yes) And maybe you, yourself, you have no money, which it is your own to do business. So ~~everytime you~~ are low (Yes) Yes (So, if you have money in your home, your business will be

prosperous?) It will be prosperous (Yes) (So who gave you the capital. Or you start

it little by little by yourself?) I started it little by little by myself like I said it,

I collect it from somebody and sell it
 If I finished and received five hundred,
 little by little ^{got something and} used it to buy some (Yes)
 (So now, can you buy more by yourself?)
 Yes (And you also give some ~~of~~ it to
 somebody) Yes (Aah, then you also have
 money) O.K. Now, I can't buy as many
 as that. If I ~~take~~^{buy} one bag, I can't buy
 more again. Somebody also can buy about
 four (Yes) Hmm. And if I buy one, and
~~it hasn't finished~~, I cannot buy one again
 (And if you have money, will you
 continue to sell the onions, or you
 would use your money in another
 business?) If I have more, I will stop
 and do another business (What kind of
 new business will be good for you?)
 I can travel (So?) Yes. (To bring what?)
 Even, this Christmas time, I can go and
~~buy~~^{bring} children, dresses and shoes. If the
 money is ~~not~~^{little} enough, you can't go, so
 you have to sell only this. (Yes)

You said you have five children?)
 Hmm. My children, they are six. (Six?)
 You said, you ~~got~~^{became} pregnant while you
 were in school?) Hmm. I left school, when
 I was in form 2. I stopped before I
 became pregnant. (Aah) Yes. So, all the
 six children, their father is still there,
 or you are the one who is taking
 care of them.) Their father is there.
 (Are all of them are with you?)
 All of them are still with me. (Hm)

So the father looks after them? Yes.

(Do you marry him?) Me, we have divorced for about three year now. (So all the children are from one father?) Yes. (And you divorced him?) Hmm (Eei you will suffer) Heiss! (You don't love him anymore) It is not because I don't love him anymore. He ~~have~~ married. (Ehee) He ~~have~~ a new wife, so he ~~seek~~ divorced. It is not my fault.

(He divorced you) Yes. If he ~~have~~ divorced you, give his children to him) Ah, we are talking about it. He said he will come for them. (If he bring you money to look after them, then its all right) At first, he brought the money. But now, he brings it anytime he likes (Hmm, then, it's a bit difficult) (Hmm. And your children, are they grown ups?) Oh, they have grown up (Some of them have completed school?) Hm, the girl ~~have~~ completed. Even, the boy also will complete very soon. But the rest are very young. (One of them would sell something?)

(The one, who have completed school?) Yes (Will she join you?) Yes, she sell something. (They ^{they} have finished school and they selling things?) Yes. (What do they sell?) She also, is in the same market. She sells, (Yes, one of them sell onions?) Hmm. (Yes) (Why did you not allowed her to continue? Or you didn't like that?) The

It was the person who looked after her,
 who did it was his fault. And myself, at that
 time, I have none to help her to continue
 (Yes) So, I also, I cannot let her stay idle.
 The person also have not made up his
 mind that, Yes, maybe the man open
 his mouth that, maybe he have now
 think about it to help her to continue,
 even, a women, it is not necessary. Maybe
 he will allow her to continue. (So, how
 many of them are still in school?) Now,
 they are four -- (I mean, Only one of
 them have completed) Hmm. And, at the
 time you started selling things in the
 market, the living, was it like now, or you
 seen some difference? Now, I am not
 like while I was staying at home. (No) (She
 said, when you started selling things, at
 first, what is the different between the
 first and now. How things was at the
 first and how things is at now, is there
 any difference?) Eee, at first, they buy
 things all right. But nowadays, when we
 are entering Christmas, they would buy
 things alright. But now, it is not ^{the same} ~~the same~~
~~that~~. There are differences. It is not ^{the same} ~~the same~~
 Now, the trading, it is not ~~the same~~ ~~the same~~
 same. (Yes) (Why is it not the same?)
 Ah, ee now, today, you cannot know how ^{it's} ~~it~~.
 Now, everything is too expensive for
 them. If they asked for something, the
 price is expensive. (Yes) You also, you
 have bought it for a ~~higher~~ price.

So, you cannot reduce it. (Yes) And if, you yourself go and buy the goods, at first, did you get it like now, or you have seen some difference? (in the business?)

At first, If I go* and buy the goods^{by} myself, (Yes. You see that, you said that, at first, they buy^{more} goods than now, But yourself, have you seen any difference in your business?) (At first, you said that, they buy good, now they don't buy goods, And have you seen the difference? have you seen any difference? Nowadays they don't buy goods. You said that the good are expensive. You see?)

Maybe at first, it was cheap. So, she want you to explain that, at first, maybe it was like this, and today, it is like this) N hmm (Yes) H mm. At first it was cheap. Because it was cheap, everybody can buy some. Even twenty if you come, you will get twenty. But now, we don't even arrange it in fifty. (Fifty cedis) Yes (You don't arrange it in fifty cedis.) Yes. So it is expensive nowadays. Some of them, the money she brings to the market, it is not enough so, she cannot buy, even hundred cedis onions. (H mm) So, if she stop buying it and do it like that, it will be fine (H mm, no) And they don't buy the goods. (Yes) (At first, when you started selling onions, many people sell onions like now?) Many people don't sell onions like now.

But now, the onions the people who are selling it, are too much. (Yes, and those people who sell onions, at first, did they work like now? do they work like now?) Those who sold onions earlier (Yes) I mean, was their work prosperous like now? It is not prosperous. It is, do you want to sell onions or do something else. But now, you don't do it like before, do you,) (I am asking how the way that they ^{sell} things is it the same? Not the price (ah!) But just the way they go and buy, whom, is it the same?) (At first, the way use to sell your goods, how you ^{go and} buy them, you see? How you use to sell goods, and now, what is the difference? in it. Maybe at first, you buy it like this, or you take lorry to that place, or they bring it to you, or we buy it ~~at~~ at this price, or we buy it at this price, or they have increased it) At first, we buy it at cheap price (yes) We also sell it at ~~cheap~~ price. (How much did you buy it?) Everyday have a different price because it is a vegetable, so, today, if it is more, if they bring it, we reduce it at a low price. But tomorrow, when it is arrived, maybe they would add about hundred cedis difference. (Yes) But it was not like now At first, the transportation ^{charge} was not difficult. (Yes) So, we also can take

money ^{and go}
^{bring some back.}
 here, (mm) So ^{there} was a way, ^{more} than today.
 (Yes) (How the cost of transportation
 is too much, you see?) Hmm (Where
 did you go for it?) (At first, did you
 buy it from the travellers like now?)
 Eh, now it is expensive from the
 travellers (Yes, but it is left with the
 price, the price, if you buy it from the
 travellers, or if you go and buy it your
 self, which of them is good?) (No, I said
 is it only the price, which have changed,
 or something else?) (She Said, is it
 only the price that have been changed,
 the price you bought it, is it the only
 thing that have been changed, or is
 there any changes again?) Eh, it is
 the price, that have been changed. The
 price of the car is high and have
 also add to it. (Yes) So, the price is
 high. The price have changed (And if
 the price have changed, is there any
 have something also changed?) No
 (Couldn't you believe believed that, may-
 be, those who grow the onions at first
 were more or they were few. Maybe
 now, those who grow it, they are ~~more~~, and
 the price is expensive or those who
 grow it at first were few and it was
 cheap) Now those who grow it are
 more. At first, those who grow it were
 few. But there was a way. In those
 days, they have no knowledge. So those

did well by us.
 who grow it were few, but they gave
 it to us in moderate price. But now
 those who grow it are more. But the
 price is high. If somebody grows it
 and harvest^a full of this, and if she
 bring it, she must give it to you, this
 'hundred', she would tell you that,
 'three hundred' (Yes) Because, she have
 grow it by herself, and she is selling it
 She would sell it at a price she
 like (Yes) So, those who grow it are
 plenty, but the price is high. First
 they were few. But is was good
 (Yes) (At the time you started selling
 onions, what was a very good job in
 this city?) (At the time you started
 selling onion in the market, what was
 a very good ^{or serious} job that was good?)

Truely, I cannot tell the good job
 at that time, which was good (Yes)
 Because (It means, what you were
 doing was good for you. You see)
 Yes, yes (But you don't have, you didn't
 see any work again?) No, I didn't see.
 (In the market) Who (But, cloth seller
 were there, Yam sellers were there, Some
 of them sold many things, Cosmetics
 and so on. So you couldn't know that
 maybe, this kind of work, is more
 profitable than Onions?) Myself, as soon
 as said, I would do it, as soon as I
 announced it, (He-he-he) And it was in my
 sight. So, I didn't set my mind on in

any business again. (Hmm) (Yes, the first time you said you attended school and now, how is the difference) Eeh when I was in school, the living. EE. (Like feeding, drinking, clothing, money matters) When I was in school, it was good. The living was good. Because,

your mother can give you fifty to school, even you can use it for feeding and you would be satisfied. Today also, if you are going to school, now, if they give you hundred cedis or even in your hands, it will not do you anything (Yes) (At the time you left school, if you didn't leave school, and the you have money in your family, and if somebody would give you a little help, what kind of work would you do? Maybe you would do?) Since I settled, when I left school, and had money, and somebody helped me, maybe I would travelled (Now) I would go and bring things. Anything, if only I go there, and see anything they would buy, anything I would bring it (Now) But, there because there was nothing there, so I come and sell this. (And those people, who travel, do they get more profit?) Yes, they get profit. (And, what kind of work is there again, which is profitable at that time?) At that time, I cannot know (Yes) (Yes, have ^{got})

Something to say or to ask Mary?)
Please, I have nothing. (All your words
in your mouth is finished, you see?)
He-he-he-he-(Yes) It is good that, the
words in your mouth is finished. Ah.
(Yes) How is trading? About trading,
maybe, ^{when} we enter December, that
they would buy the goods, But now
the trading is slow. (They don't
buy it) Yes (Yes) Ah Hum)
