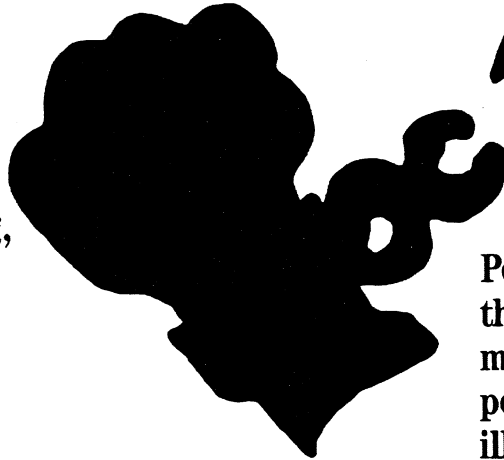


# Africa Peace Tour
