

The Southern Africa Alliance Conference is a joint undertaking focusing on the West Coast organizing on issues about Southern Africa. It represents the efforts of four existing organizations to advance and consolidate Southern Africa support work on a regional basis. The theme of the Conference will be "U.S. Out of Southern Africa".

GOALS and OBJECTIVES

The objectives are:

- 1) To bring together all the various student and community-based organizations working on different activities on Southern Africa;
- 2) To create a vehicle for the promotion of further activities, such as protests, boycotts, picketing, research and study groups, etc., on the West Coast. This vehicle is intended to take the form of a coalition;
- 3) To make a contribution thereby to the growing movements against the apartheid system in Southern Africa;
- 4) To consolidate the gains so far achieved by these movements, and thus secure a solid base from which to broaden and expand their activities;
- 5) To eventually work for a coalition with groups across North America.

For the realization of these objectives, the Conference strives to fulfill two immediate goals:

- a) Appoint a steering committee to coordinate future tasks and to act as an administrative body of the coalition;
- b) Choose and adopt an appropriate name for the coalition.

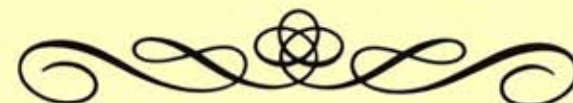
