Democratic forces in South Africa have requested international observers as part of their strategy to assure that South Africa's first non-racial democratic elections are free and fair. It is hoped that the presence of these observers will deter election fraud and violent intimidation during the final days of the campaign as well as during the days of voting and counting ballots. We urge you to participate in this historic event which marks the turning point in struggle of the South African majority for freedom and justice. Those interested must commit to:

- spend a minimum of 2 weeks in South Africa from approximately 4/16/94 -to 5/4/94
- complete an application and interview process
- attend orientation and training sessions
- cover their own expenses individually or through sponsoring organizations
