NEW RESOURCES: The Committee for a Free Mozambique (CFM) is in the process of preparing two new sources of material both on the struggle in Mozambique and the relationship of groups in the U.S. to that liberation. These include a 10 page booklet on the history of colonialism, resistance, liberation in Mozambique as well as U.S. involvement, and a new leaflet brochure on CFM. Both pieces are meant to be short and readable and cheap or free. Write to CFM for the booklet entitled OUR DREAM HAS THE SIZE OF FREEDOM--The Struggle for Liberation in Mozambique (cost 10¢ each, 15 for \$1.00, 100 for \$5.00), and the brochure entitled SUPPORT THE MOZAMBIKAN STRUGGLE (Free).

ACTIVITIES: CFM aided the U.S. Representative of FRELIMO, S.M. Khan, in the September 25 commemoration of the beginning of the armed struggle in Mozambique. A public meeting was held near the United Nations and speakers represented the O.A.U., Southern African Liberation movements, African missions to the U.N. and African student groups. In terms of material support to FRELIMO CFM is continuing to raise monies for transistor radios and investigating the best way to deliver them to FRELIMO. The goal of collecting \$400 before purchasing the transistors has been three-quarters reached. CFM is also planning a button as asked by FRELIMO for use in Africa; it will have a FRELIMO logo and inscription in FRELIMO colors. The Committee is planning to distribute literature at several meetings coming up this fall in New York; to expand its available literature list, and collect information of films. Finally, CFM is joining with others in establishing a monthly political education group based on joint readings.

VISITORS: Steve Goldfield of Oakland LSM attended a CFM meeting in early October reporting on the food and clothes campaigns LSM has conducted. CFM is now in correspondence with LSM Information Center in Vancouver about raising funds in relation to a printing press for MPLA in Angola. Steve reported of his research on Dow and the use of herbicides in Angola and collected some new information here in New York. It was good to meet with him and we hope to keep in touch.
